Facility Use Rules & Regulations

IX. LAKES, BEACHES AND PARKS

A. GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

1. The Association reserves the right to restrict the use of lakes and beaches, or selected areas of lakes and beaches, for the holding of special events or repair work.
2. THERE ARE NO LIFE GUARDS ON DUTY AT THE LAKES AND BEACH AREAS. Anyone swimming in the lakes does so at their own risk.
3. For health and safety purposes, appropriate swimming attire shall be worn while swimming. (\$50.00)

B. SPECIFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Any act that threatens the ecology of the lakes, including placing any foreign material in the lakes, is prohibited. (\$100.00)
2. Camping is prohibited on all beaches and areas surrounding the lakes. (\$50.00)
3. Swimming is permitted in open water with an orange flag visible. (\$100.00)
4. For health and safety purposes, persons under fourteen (14) years of age entering the water must be supervised by a responsible adult eighteen (18) years of age or older. (\$100.00)
5. Playing with the buoys and rope equipment at designated swimming areas is strictly prohibited. (\$100.00)
6. Breakable containers are prohibited in beach areas and all Common Areas within the Silver Lakes Development. (\$100.00)
7. Open fires are prohibited on Association property, unless approved by Association management. (\$100.00)
8. Pets are prohibited in parks, fishing areas, beach areas and marinas. Service animals must be under the control of their owner at all times. Dogs on leashes are allowed at Parmelee Field during regularly scheduled games. Owners are responsible for the immediate pick up and proper disposal of their dog's leavings. (\$100.00)
9. All power driven vehicles as defined by the California Motor Vehicle Code are prohibited on Association parks, sidewalks, beaches, and grass areas. Except currently registered Silver Lakes Association members' golf carts will be allowed on the fields at Parmelee during regularly scheduled games. All drivers of such carts shall be sixteen (16) years of age or older and have a valid driver's license in their possession. (\$100.00)
10. Feeding of ducks, coots, widgeon, and other wildlife found in or around the lakes, parks, golf course and ponds, or other Common Areas within the Silver Lakes Development is prohibited. (\$100.00)
11. Golf practice is prohibited at parks and beaches. (\$100.00)
